
Prof. Jianguo Zhang

Professor Jianguo Zhang is a distinguished neurological expert affiliated with Capital Medical University's Beijing Tiantan Hospital. He serves as the Director of Functional Neurosurgery at this institution, while also leading Beijing's key laboratory for neuromodulation research and treatment.

With over 30 years of expertise in functional neurological disorders, Professor Zhang pioneered the use of deep brain stimulation to treat Parkinson's disease in China and established the country's first national-level multi-specialty neuromodulation treatment system. He founded the Chinese Neuromodulation Alliance and has made significant contributions to the clinical validation of domestically produced brain stimulators.

His academic positions include serving as a committee member of the Chinese Medical Association's Neuromodulation Committee, Vice President of the Chinese Anti-Epilepsy Association, and the executive director with the World Society for Stereotactic and Functional Neurosurgery.

Professor Zhang's research has been published in prestigious international journals including Lancet Neurology, JAMA Neurology, Nature Communications, and Brain, with over 150 research papers in the past five years. His contributions have been recognized with numerous awards, including first-prize honors from the National Science and Technology Progress Award and the Chinese Medical Association.
